

Major Canadian Natural Gas Producer Buys AnyWhere/AnyTime Services from Industrial Evolution

Services enable engineers and operators to access gas well production data in real-time from any Internet-connected PC

EDMONTON, ALBERTA, CANADA, March 12, 2001— Industrial Evolution today announced that it has been successful in selling its AnyWhere/AnyTime services to one of the largest oil and gas companies operating in Canada.

The initial project will draw data from the embedded historian of an Emerson Delta-V DCS and make it available in a Web browser to engineers and operators. Users will be able to view data via schematics, similar to those on Delta-V control system, by accessing a secure Web site. Simply clicking on any value on the screen will invoke options to allow the user to create ad hoc trends or download data to their own PC.

This project is a first for the Canadian oil and gas industry, and is a pre-cursor to future projects whereby non-operating joint venture partners will be granted access to the same data, but restricted by ownership.
